PREPARING OUR STUDENTS FOR LIFE AFTER HIGH SCHOOL

- 71% of our students have earned college credit prior to graduating high school through our four dual credit university partners.
- 72% of our students are taking AP courses.
- Students have access to 10 different career and technical education concentrations including engineering, health sciences, transportation, construction, education, information technology, business, arts/media and government/law.
 - 46% of seniors have earned a work based learning opportunity.



- 90% of students attend either a 2 or 4 year college program.
- 54% of our students go to 4 year universities.
- 36% of our students go to 2 year college.
- 5% join the military.
- 3% enter both college and the workforce at the same time.
